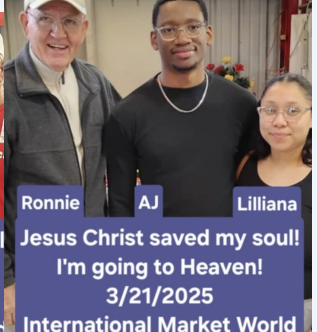
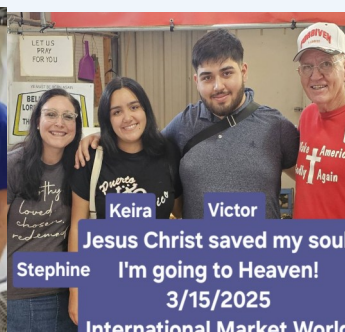

We have been helping at Eastside Baptist Church in Mulberry, where Jacob has been serving as translator for the Spanish families who attend on Sunday mornings. Their church has voted to start reaching out to the legal migrant camps to try to get them plugged into church as well. They are planning to start hosting and teaching English as a second language class on Saturdays at the church. Jacob is 1 of 2 bi-lingual Spanish speakers at the church and Steph and Alex are still training daily. The hope and prayer is that this work will turn into a Spanish church plant. Additionally, in recent weeks, we have been able to help lead music to ease the burden of the leaders. Growing pains can be a challenge and we are thankful to be able to help.

In addition to translating, teaching and singing, & one on one discipleship with young men, Jacob has had the opportunity to preach at local ABA churches. We were at First Thonotosassa on Sunday, March 23 where he taught Sunday School, led music & preached both services. This church has a heart for doctrine and scripture memorization that has been instilled in them by their pastor, Joshua Simpson.
